TORI STUD FARM

Tori Stud Farm (est. 1856) is located at historical Tori Manor Estate. Horses are of Tori and Estonian indigenous breed. Tori breed was initiated in 1892 by using a Norfolk Roadster stallion called Hetman for cross-breeding. Tori Stud Farm is a unique symbol of Estonian cultural heritage, and the whole complex including the horses is under development to become a sophisticated Equine Centre offering various services.

The story of Mooste manor (german Moisekatz) goes back to the 16th century when the king of Poland, Stefan Batory, gave its territory to the county judge of Võnnu, Wilhelm Sturtz. After that the manor's territory went through the hands of many, before being obtained by the von Nolckens in 1810. They ran the manor for about a 100 years and left us most of the legacy we have now.



The Heimtali Manor, founded in the 19th century, consists of a classicist main building, a ruler's house, a unique stable, and a beautiful distillery with four chimneys.

Around the heart of the manor, on the banks of the ancient Raudna Primeval Valley, is the Heimtali forest park.
